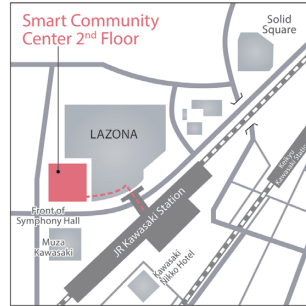
Audio Guide

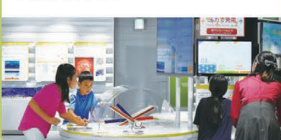

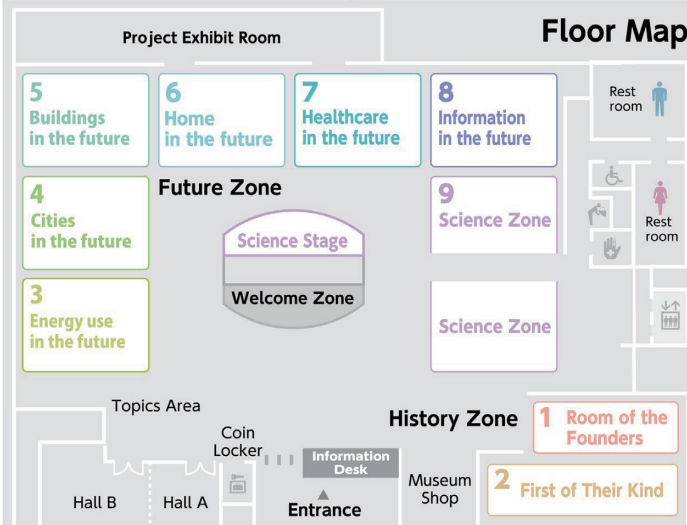
